Obligations of membership are the earnest efforts to be active in participation in the monthly meetings and traditional observances; to pay the annual dues (current dues for membership are indicated at the end of this application); and once each 9-12 months to serve as host/hostess in the HOUSE OF DENMARK on a Sunday afternoon or at one of the monthly meetings.

Hosting the Cottage involves the making of coffee or other beverages for visitors; furnishing “something”, preferably traditional Danish items such as Danish coffee cakes, cookies or finger foods which are available to guests and visitors. Also, the host/hostess will greet the guests and visitors in a friendly manner willing to supply information concerning Denmark or the curios that are displayed throughout the Cottage. The coordinator of the hosting services, Board member with title of Social Secretary, will provide a briefing and assistance in your first experience or arrange for you to serve with a co-host/hostess on this first experience. The hosting on Sunday lasts 4 hours. The Cottage has to be open 4 consecutive hours between 12 noon and 5 p.m. The Cottage is expected to be cleaned for the following Sunday’s host/hostess. More detailed instructions will be furnished in due time. THE PROMISE is that the experience is very rewarding with an opportunity to meet many interesting folks, often tourists of Danish background or even from the “old” country.
